### Accommodation

We will be staying at **Wombat City Hostel**. What used to be sailors' lodgings back in the 1800s is now a modern hostel. With great attention to detail, Wombat's celebrates the legacy of the historic building. Old oak that was previously part of sturdy ships and churches is now immortalized in the furniture throughout the house.

Wombat City Hostel is situated in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, right next to famous Tower Bridge and Tower of London, charming markets, authentic pubs, and plenty of other historic sights. A short walk will see you in the trendy Borough of Shoreditch with vibrant street art, pulsing life and some of the best curries outside of India. All other hotspots in London are easily accessible by public transport from Aldgate East and Tower Hill.

In the morning a Tasty Brekkie buffet ensures you have enough energy for your exciting day, and in the evening Wombat's awaits you with free WiFi, a cozy courtyard, spacious lobby and womBAR. Here you can unwind and enjoy yourself.

You will be staying in rooms of 6-8 beds with ensuite bathrooms and private lockers. You must bring your own towel but bedding is provided.

### Transportation in London

We recommend using your contactless credit card (Visa, Mastercard, etc.) for public transport. It works the same way as Oyster Cards: simply tap in/out at gates, and you will be charged the same fare. Visitor Oyster Cards and Travelcards can also be ordered in advance or purchased at Underground stations.

## **Baggage allowance**

- 1 checked bag: Max. 20 kg. and dimension 250cm in total (length + width + height)
- 1 cabin bag: Max. 10 kg. and dimensions 55 x 40 x 23cm

Liquids in cabin bag must be placed in one resealable 1-litre plastic bag with containers of max. 100 ml each. Larger liquids must be packed in checked bag.
